

Automated External Defibrillators (AED)

Overview

Early defibrillation is critical to survival from cardiac arrest. In a witnessed collapse, **early** defibrillation can increase survival up to 75%. This course offers training in the use of an automated defibrillator.

The course content is in accordance with the current European and UK Resuscitation guidelines.
